Courageous Conversations about Death and Dying – A different education approach

For several years, we have attempted to build appetite for face-to-face education about how clinicians tackle difficult conversations about death and dying; nobody wanted to talk about this topic? The Covid 19 pandemic has brought much fear, however also urgency and opportunity to prepare frontline clinicians.

Our community need us to hear them, in the moments of courage when they ask questions about their life and death, crucially palliative care or when they are dying. As the program author I was keen to ensure it is different by providing food for thought education to translate into all clinicians' bedside practice.

Courageous Conversations about Death and Dying (CCDD) is a face-to-face workshop available to staff in all roles and from across all healthcare settings, to ensure those chosen by a person in our care, hear them share their fears or thoughts about dying or the end of their life and respond in a supportive and honest way.

The programme is wrapped in person centred care, with identified CCDD team members in a dual role of presenters and participant companions. The companion welcomes each participant and are available throughout, so that all feel person centred care support and are ready to learn during the emotionally charged workshop. Local actors provide a magic that no other education on this topic across the state brings ... live theatre!

The programme is evaluated through PEPA (Program of Experience in Palliative Approach) and 96% of participants state improvements in confidence and knowledge across the topics, with all feeling more comfortable sitting and hearing the voices

of our patients when they need us to the most. It is making a huge difference and has finally truly begun the conversations we all must be capable of.

Future-proofing the profession: A think tank for nursing and midwifery Symposium

There is much debate about the future of the nursing and midwifery workforce as we move towards 2030. This debate centres on the roles and responsibilities, models of education and care that are needed to address global health inequality and sustainability.

Early in 2018, the Australian and New Zealand Council of Deans of Nursing and Midwifery (CDNM) conceived an idea to bring together interested parties to debate, explore and understand the issues that academia and the profession need to consider as we move towards 2030. This coincided with the launch of the [Nursing Now Campaign](#), which in collaboration with the WHO and ICN, aims to raise the status and profile of nursing. [Australia - [Nursing Now – Australian College of Nursing \(acn.edu.au\)](#)]

More recently the commitment to develop a [National Australian Nurse Strategy](#) make these discussions ever important, as we seek to inform the future development of the professions.

In order to future proof and empower our professions, this symposium will explore the following themes:

- ✎ Who is the nurse or midwife of the future?
 - Understanding the knowledge, skills and attributes needed for practice.
- ✎ What approaches and models of education are needed to prepare nurses and midwives for the future?
 - How should we educate the nurse or midwife of the future?
 - What models of education will be needed to ensure professional responsiveness?
 - How will we enable professionalism?
- ✎ What is the purpose of professionalism in nursing and midwifery?
 - How do we educate for professionalism?
 - What types of environments enable professionalism?
- ✎ Where are the transition points and how do we negotiate these?
 - Transition to university, the transition to work, the transition to leadership, transition within specialities.
 - The symposium will bring together nursing and midwifery leaders, managers, clinicians, academics, and researchers engaged in education, regulation, and practice.

At the conclusion of the symposium, the [Council of Deans of Nursing and Midwifery](#) anticipate the production of a set of white papers, which will inform the CDNM strategic direction.

On behalf of the CDNM, we value your participation in the symposium and look forward to seeing you on the beautiful Sunshine Coast.

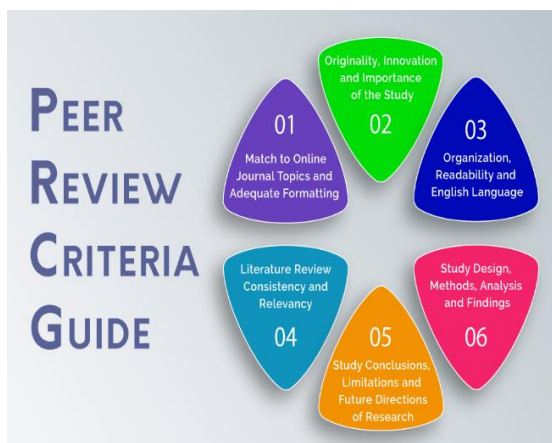
1. Submitting an article for peer review

So, what's Peer Review all about:

The key position of peer review is about ensuring that submitted articles have a level of quality control of published information, assign credit for the work of others, disseminate current knowledge and in some instances archive our existing knowledge as nurses, midwives, and educators.

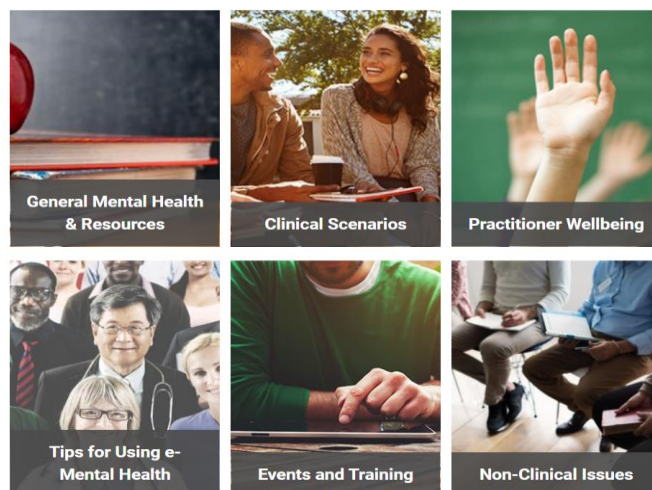

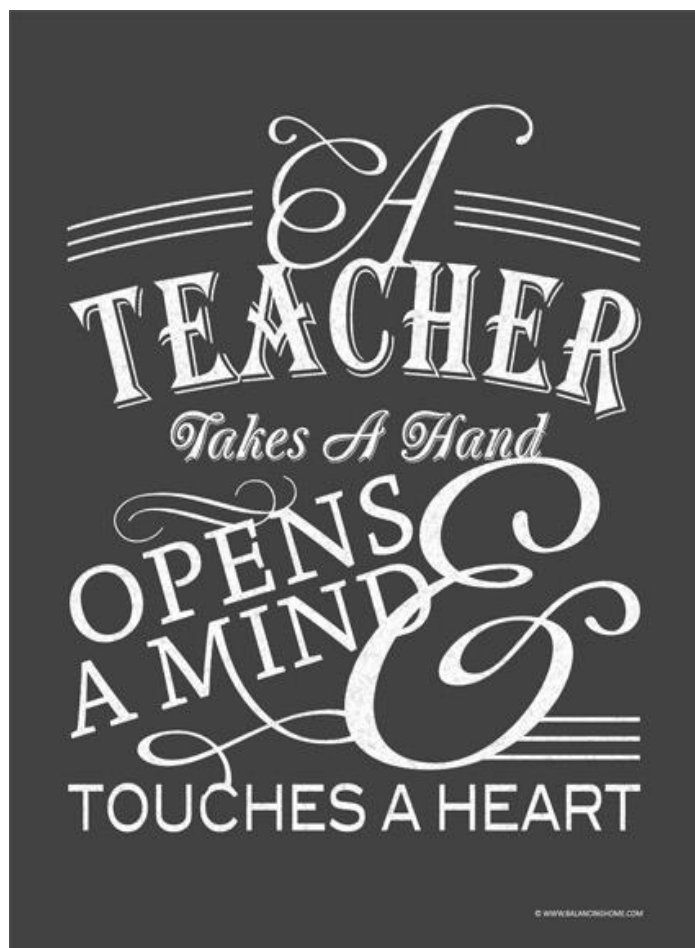
