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From the Outgoing President’s Desk

Hello colleagues,

It has been an interesting year as we finally begin to emerge from the pandemic. Most of us expected 2022 to be the year that we emerged, bur anecdotal evidence is that the pandemic appeared to impact most strongly in 2022 – in both the clinical and higher education sectors. This may have been due to:

1. Loss of experienced and valued staff from both areas associated with the workplace demands, organisational restructuring,

and lack of recognition of the work of nurse teachers

2. Exhaustion with continuing the education required with fewer people to provide it
3. Nurse teachers being moved from education roles to work in the clinical area

It is with great gusto that I thank our current National Committee for their continued involvement in ANTS. We are spreading nationally once again with members across Australia and the National Committee members reflect this with representatives from Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria, and South Australia. The good news is we also are gaining younger members on the National Committee who bring a different and refreshing perspective to discussions. We are looking forward to even more new membership as both the President (myself) and Treasurer (Christine) step down from these roles.

Special thanks to Dr Christine Taylor and Stuart Taylor (Administrator) for all their work, and it has been significant work, as well as time they have put into supporting and maintaining the ANTS organisation. ANTS owes a significant debt of gratitude to both Christine and Stuart, who are taking long service leave but will remain in contact with ANTS, for their knowledge and support since they joined the ANTS way before time began.

The Coalitional of National Nursing & Midwifery Organisations (CoNNMO) meetings were attended by the President during the second half of the year 2022. Like all organisations, CoNNMO is undergoing personnel changes as we exit the pandemic.

Educator Standards Review: The project is currently undergoing ethical review. The scoping review protocol has been registered in Open Science Framework (<https://osf.io/>) and the review almost completed. As discussed at the National Nurse Educators Conference (NNEC) Conference the project will roll out under the guidance of Dr Christine Taylor as Chief Investigator. Keep alert for invitations to participate in focus groups in the future.

The 19th NNEC held at the Gold Coast in June 2023 was a success. It was a pleasure to meet so many nurses involved in teaching nurses from across Australia and New Zealand and the generosity in which they shared their ideas, knowledge, and skills. There is a Conference Report available with the AGM documents on the ANTS website. Financially it was also a success for ANTS. The organizers have advised that a full report will be available in a couple of months as the accounts are finalised.

We look forward to seeing you all at the Australasian Educators Conference in New Zealand in 2024, which will be run and hosted by our NZ colleagues in nursing education, the details of which will be made available on the ANTS website when they are confirmed.

The following are excerpts from the latest newsletter from the NMBA – June 2023 (including the photograph of AP Veronica Casey)

Updates form recent NMBA meetings

The NMBA will shortly be inviting participation as part of their public consultations to support the growth and flexibility of the nursing & midwifery professions. This will include:

- Draft registration standard: General Registration for internationally qualified Registered Nurses - Closes 20th October
- a review of the Nurse Practitioner endorsement registration standard and
- re-entry to practice pathways.
- Two further possible changes to the National Boards' English language skills requirements – Closes 13th September 2023
- Review of the Criminal history registration standard and other work to improve public safety – Closed 14th September 2023

Retirement of the Registration standard: endorsement for scheduled medicines for registered nurses (rural & isolated practice) aka RIP endorsement

Following consultation on a proposal to retire the Registration standard: Endorsement for scheduled medicines for registered nurses (rural & isolated practice) in 2015, the NMBA determined that there was broad support from stakeholders. At that stage only 2 states (Queensland and Victoria) required that RNs held the endorsement. Alternative regulatory mechanisms for RNs to obtain, supply and administer schedule 2, 3, 4 and 8 medicines in rural & isolated practice settings without the endorsement have now been finalised by these 2 states.

Consequently, the RIP endorsement is no longer required for RNs to obtain, supply and administer schedule 2, 3, 4 and 8 medicines in rural & isolated practice settings in any Australian state or territory. Therefore, the NMBA have written to the Australian Health Ministers requesting approval for the registration standard to be retired. This has now been endorsed. While RNs will no longer required this endorsement, they will need to work within their state and territory legislation and workplace requirements.

The NMBA indicates that these changes ensure that the current model of care enabled by the RIP endorsement can continue without the need for NMBA regulation. The NMBA will soon write to all RNs with the endorsement to let them know what this change means for them and to include information on their website to explain the change.

National Nursing & Midwifery Education Advisory Network – What is it?

The National Nursing & Midwifery Education Advisory Network (NNMEAN) works with Chief Nursing & Midwifery Office and the Australian Government Department of Health & Aged Care to give advice on nursing & midwifery education and workforce issues.

Formed in 2015, NNMEAN's role is to give high-level strategic advice to health ministers. It uses an evidence-based approach to plan and manage education, employment and immigration for nurses and midwives in Australia, including nurse practitioners (NPs), Registered Nurses (RNs), Enrolled Nurses (ENs) and Midwives.

To support the Australian Government Department of Health & Aged Care NNMEAN works alongside the [Nursing & Midwifery Strategic Reference Group](#) (NMSRG) to give advice on:

- ▣ education of nurses and midwives to meet the health needs of the Australian community
- ▣ factors effecting nurses and midwives entering the workforce
- ▣ how entry and development pathways can shape future careers
- ▣ national supply and demand workforce reports
- ▣ health workforce reports to inform policy advice and strategy
- ▣ specific requests by health ministers

The NNMEAN generally meets 3 times a year but may meet more of the is required. Communiques are posted on the NNMEAN website. The Chief Nursing & Midwifery Officer Decision acts as the secretariat for NNMEAN.

Factors that influence health professionals team communication in emergencies: Findings from a constructivist grounded theory study.

Factors that influence health professional team communication in emergencies:

Development of a model to explain uncertainty in team communication

INTRODUCTION

Ineffective communication is a significant contributing factor to poor clinical outcomes for patients. Educators are in a unique position to make a difference in influencing improvements in team communication.

METHODS

Using constructivist grounded theory methodology, interviews and video observation of N = 21 final year nursing students in seven teams were conducted using deteriorating patient simulated scenarios. The Team Emergency Assessment Measure (TEAM) (Cooper et al., 2008) was used by the participants to rate their own and other team members teamwork in relation to simulation-based education (SBE) expert-raters.

FINDINGS

The data from the TEAMS rating tool indicates that participants self-rated their team performance of non-technical skills as being consistently higher than experts in every area. In interviews, participants discussed stress, anxiety and lack of confidence. Contributions to communication apprehension include factors such as cultural and linguistic background, life, work and family experiences, gender and age and environmental factors (mask wearing and simulation fidelity).

DISCUSSION




Figure 1: The Theoretical Model

The theory (Figure 1) raises awareness of the social processes during team communication. The student context, composition and roles of team members are important considerations. The TEAMS tool (Table 1) provides a useful 'snapshot' of the participant's self-rating of team skills compared to expert-raters.

CONCLUSION

The study highlights obstacles that can assist educators and academics to structure effective team communication education. Uncertainty tolerance and communication apprehension theory should be applied to educational frameworks to develop traits of grit, resilience and positive mindset to assist learners.

Jane and Cecilia walked us through deciding what was important when determining simulation workshops and talked about how it's not high or low fidelity that is important but determining the right fidelity for the learning situation. Participants worked in clinics and rural areas and soon realised that you do not need very expensive mannequins to conduct a simulation event. It was a great learning experience.
- The [Wolter Kluwer Breakfast](#) session highlighted that using evidence based clinical resources and digital competency assessment programmes in nursing and was also enjoyed by those who attended.
- The [Leadership Masterclass](#) provided by Letitia Del Fabbro was an innovative workshop where learners had to look at themselves from three leadership perspectives. First using the five whys – in why you want to be a nurse leader. Secondly, participants had to draw a representation of how they saw themselves and others saw them as leaders; and thirdly by accessing a questionnaire to find out what kind of leader they were. Letitia indicated that it wasn't about her telling participants how to be a leader but about each of the participants looking at ourselves and working out why and how we will lead.

Member Review - NNEC 2023

In the early hours of June 6th, 2023, a small group of intrepid educators from the College of Nursing and Health Sciences, Flinders University, South Australia set flight to the bright lights and razzle dazzle of the Gold Coast. The destination was NNEC2023 – the 19th National Nurse Education Conference, organised by the Australian Nurse Teachers' Society (ANTS) and the Conference Organising Committee. As one of these educators, I was excited by the opportunity

to engage with clinical experts, hospital educators, academics, managers, and other health educators, all with a commitment and passion for nurse education. **Photograph:** College of Nursing and Health Sciences, Flinders University team (Provided)

Nurse education can be challenging and rewarding (as we all know), and the shared and varied experiences of the presenters reflected these realities. On Day 1 of the conference, the Welcome to Country, welcomed all delegates to the traditional lands of the Yugambah and allowed us to reflect on the importance of meeting together. Professor Shelley Nowlan, the Chief Nursing and Midwifery Officer for Queensland Health, discussed career pathways for graduate Nurses and Midwives and sustaining our Nursing and Midwifery workforce. And Clinical Associate Professor Bernadette Thomson addressed the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on the Nursing workforce and the opportunities to build on the creativity and innovation that have emerged during this time. After an opportunity to grab a coffee and a bite to eat and chat with other delegates, we were able to move into one of three rooms where a range of topics were presented.

I wished I could have attended all three sessions but using The Event App made navigating the extensive program much easier. My morning was spent in Conference Room 1, where Kalpana Raghunathan presented *Collaborating to meet changing digital health workforce demands: Integrating electronic medical record education in nursing curricula*; and Professor Samantha Heath presented *Future nursing workforce: Creating, innovating and energising undergraduate curriculum content through stakeholder collaboration*. Further presentations followed, as I moved from room to room.

All too soon it was time for lunch, and I must say that the meals provided were delicious and catered to many different dietary requirements and tastes. So, filled with food and loaded up with caffeine, it was time for the keynote presentation – *Growing a connected and insight-enabled workforce through innovation* – by Damian Green, the Deputy Director-General for eHealth Queensland. This presentation was followed by a panel discussion on *The impact of artificial intelligence in healthcare and education*.

In the afternoon, I attended *A simulation-based intensive induction program for graduate Registered Nurses* by Natalie Rees. We then moved into the Exhibition Room for the Welcome Reception and the opportunity to meet with other delegates and exhibitors. Unsurprisingly, after such a busy day, it was time for sleep with the promise of more to learn on Day 2 of the conference.

On Day 2, I attended the *Wolters-Kluwer-Lippincott breakfast session* – which focused on nursing transformation and empowerment through evidence-based solutions to drive clinical excellence, quality patient care and improve staff engagement. From this early morning start, I attended the keynote presentation – *Creating creative thinkers* by Professor Amanda Wilson. I was also fortunate to listen to my colleague, Kerry Billing, present *First Year Student Nurses' Experiences with High Fidelity Simulation prior to Initial Clinical Placement*. I nervously awaited my own presentation - *Nursing Informatics and Undergraduate nursing education* – and true to form, there was a slight glitch in technology which was quickly resolved by the technical support team. The questions and feedback I received were worth all of the nerves. That evening I met with other delegates for a BBQ Dinner at the Boatshed with music, games and lots of discussion on what we had gained from the conference so far.

On the final day of the conference, following the keynote presentation – *Failure to fail* by Dr Lynda Hughes and a panel discussion on *Energising the profession*, two of my Flinders University colleagues presented their work. Dr Didy Button presented *An innovative online international collaboration supporting student learning and* Tegan Putsey presented *Enhancing and Supporting Undergraduate Nursing Students in the Paediatric Setting*. That evening we headed out to Surfers Paradise to enjoy the sights and an evening meal, before preparing for the flight home the next morning.

So, what did I learn as a delegate and presenter at NNEC 2023 – the 19th National Nurse Education Conference? I discovered delegates working in the same educational space of digital health and nursing informatics as me, I received resources to use in my studies (thank you Dr Heath for your advice on Delphi reporting tools!) and I made connections with educators throughout Australia and New Zealand. For me, the conference truly lived up to its promise to **Create, Innovate** and **Energise** by creating connections, sharing educational innovations and energising me as a nurse educator and PhD candidate to keep striving for excellence in my practice. We also held a focus group at the Conference to discuss the Standards, where some great suggestions were made from the attendees.



Book Review: Applied Anatomy & Physiology: An Interdisciplinary Approach (2020) by Zerina Tomkins

Since it has been a while since my initial nursing study days opening a textbook, especially an anatomy textbook, was anticipated to be a challenging read. However, I was pleasantly surprised. The structure of this textbook and the use of case studies and clinical practice focus really seems to take the more abstract (and what could be considered 'drier') topic of anatomy and give it a true applied sense. The information was very applied in nature and moved away

from the traditional organ or system focused format to a more patient centred approach, in line with our clinical practice goals!

The focus on the normal and having a good understanding on this is a strong starting point for learners and readers. Moving to discussions of the abnormal and disease states is certainly left as the next steps in the health professionals learning process and not specifically covered in this text. However, the coverage of the normal puts them in good stead for applying this knowledge when encountering patients.

The text has attempted to address the life span of paediatric to geriatric and other special populations like maternity but not to a full extent. It draws some comparisons and highlights differences but is just a starting point for addressing the unique characteristics of these populations. The text is primarily adult focused and that seems to be a decision made to ensure that the information presented is comprehensive for its target audience. The comparisons and highlighting of key differences between adults and paediatric and geriatric populations is an interesting point to make and can spark the reader to explore further readings if their interest lies within these speciality populations.

A standout chapter is the one exclusively on pain. The in-depth focus on this as its own entity is interesting and very applicable to a large range of patients which our health professional's encounter.

Finally, the illustrations are eye catching and very clear in the information they are trying to convey.

Overall, this textbook is an 'easy' read for an anatomy textbook and really well tailored for a good introductory text for beginning health professionals.




