What is NHET-Sim?

The NHET-Sim Program or the National Health Education and Training in Simulation Program is a nationwide training program in simulation for healthcare professionals.

It is designed for anyone who currently or intends to use simulation as an educational method to support the development of healthcare students and professionals. It is open to all health professions.

Why should professionals register for the NHET-Sim Program?

The Program provides a way for current and future simulation educators and technicians to consolidate or expand their knowledge and skills. Modules have been developed utilising content experts from across Australia. The program provides flexible learning with elearning and workshops. The Program is provided free of charge.

All registrants complete two core modules prior to undertaking two or more elective modules. S9 and S10 participants must have completed two core and two elective modules prior to commencement.

C2 - covers educational theories underpinning simulation.

S2 & S4 - introduces scenario development as participants develop and deliver a scenario.

S5 & S6 - focusing on working with simulated patients, includes selection of simulated patients, orientation and blended simulation modalities:

S9 - examines debriefing practices in detail.
S10 - provides the opportunity to develop a scenario and receive feedback.
