

Introduction







Course Aim

The aim of this short course was to provide participants working in health facilities caring for patients requiring palliative care with the knowledge and skills to apply and evaluate care for patients and their families requiring this specialised approach to care.





Course Objectives

At the completion of this course students would be able to:

- explain the principles of palliative care;
- * Communicate effectively with the patient, family and health professional while providing cultural appropriate care;
- identify the legal and ethical issues associated with palliative care; and
- * Identify the normal grieving process for the patient and family while being aware of the indicator of complex grief
- * incorporate debriefing and self-care within their roles.




Pre and Post evaluation




Participant ratings of their knowledge of various aspects versity of relating to palliative care provision


