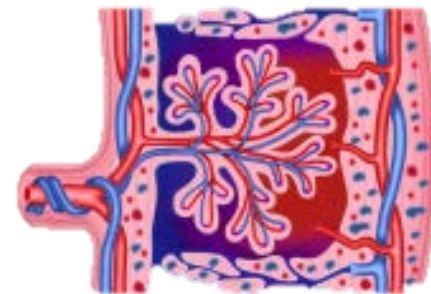

- Deliver educational and debriefing sessions



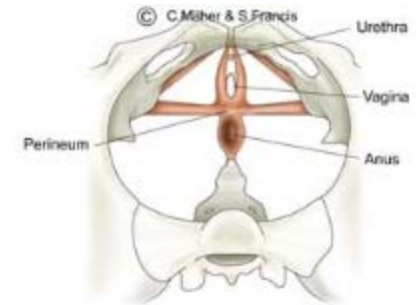
Purpose

Improve the delivery of clinical facilitation onsite

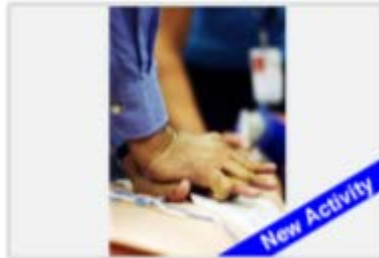
